



Coaches Role

All BASC coaches must meet high criteria set forth by USA Swimming. Each coach is a certified lifeguard and holds a current First Aid and CPR Training for the Professional Rescuer certification. Coaches are also required to complete the USA Swimming Safety Training for Coaches Course.

BASC coaches have also passed a background check. All of the above requirements must be kept up to date for a swim coach to remain in good standing with USA Swimming and the Blue Arrow Swimming Club.

BASC coaches' main responsibility is to mold all of our swimmers into the best swimmers that they can be. In addition, coaches mentor swimmers in life skills and positive values.

Coaches shall build relationships with team families, to achieve mutually-set goals for each swimmer.

Coaches also help the team to build relationships with other aquatic organizations.
